Goals and objectives of the festival

- The main goal of the contest is to identify, popularize and demonstrate the most striking and impressive examples of creativity, to foster taste and love of art and professional performance.
- The objectives of the festival:
 - ✓ The development of creative activity;
 - ✓ The search for new talents;
 - ✓ The professional development, the exchange of experience;
 - ✓ Uniting of children and youth from different countries and cities.

Contest Terms

- Creative children and youth groups of different ages, as well as individual performers of instrumental, choreographic, and theatre genres from countries around the world are invited to participate in contests.
- Students of professional schools are rated in the category "Professionals".
- Each team or participant has the right to participate in several categories. Each performance is
- evaluated separately.

- The order of contest performances is established by the organizing committee of the Festival.
- A professional jury evaluates contest performances according to a 10-point system and determines diploma winners, laureates of I, II, III degrees in each nomination and category.
- The Grand Prix of the contest is awarded by voting of all members of the jury. All groups are awarded with diplomas and souvenirs.

Nominations:

- Choreography (folk, modern, pop, ballroom dance, ballet) - solo, ensembles;
- Performers on folk instruments - solos, ensembles;
- Instrumental music - solos, ensembles (small form), ensembles;
- Theatres (dramatic, musical, puppet);
- Artistic word (readers) - solo.

Categories:

- solo
- duet
- small group (3-7 people)
- group (8 and more people)

Age categories of participants:

- 1st age category: 9-10 years old
- 2d age category: 11-12 years old
- 3d age category: 13-15 years old
- 4th age category: 16 years old-18 years old

The age category is determined at the time of the performance. In a duet - according to the senior participant, in groups - according to the majority of participants.

Temporary regulations:

- Solo - up to 3.00 min .;
- Duet - up to 4.00 min .;
- Small group - up to 5.00 min .;
- Group - up to 6 min.;
- Theater — up to 30 min.;
- Readers — up to 5 min..

Evaluation Criteria (maximum score 10 points)

- clean and technical execution;
- artistry;
- composition integrity and technical complexity;
- general form

Rules of work of the organizing committee and the jury

Organizing Committee:

- makes decisions on the structure of the Jury;
- coordinates the work of the Jury during the Festival;
- determines the order of rehearsals and performances of contestants;
- performs other functions in accordance with this Regulation on the Festival.

Jury:

- carries out refereeing in accordance with this Regulation on the Festival;
- evaluates the contest performances of participants according to a 10-point system, taking into account the following criteria: cleanliness and technical performance, musicality and artistry, integrity

Rewarding:

- The results of the competition and awards are summarized in nominations taking into account age categories and provide for the awarding of the title of Grand Prix holder, laureates of I, II, III degree in each category and nomination, as well as diplomats and participants with the presentation of diplomas.
- Participants with the same number of points receive the same rewards.
- All teachers are awarded with Letters of Appreciation and Certificates for completing Continuing Education Courses in the areas of Choreography, Theatre, Arts

To participate you must:

1. Application (for each contest number is filled out separately).
2. The list of the collective with all participants and accompanying people, with the data of an identity document (for residence).
3. Video with a competitive number (a link to the video can be indicated in the Application or attach as a separate file with the application).
4. If you need to receive an Invitation for visas, please send scans of international passports.
